The Blue Devils scored 25 points in the opening quarter, leading 25-5.

"Our guys came out like men possessed," said Windsor coach Silas Pogue. "We finally had a night where we limited

the other team to one offensive possession and did a great job of keeping Arcola off the glass. Warner is leading us in scoring as a freshman and he experiences some growing pains from time to time, but his shot selection has improved over the last several games.
